It utilizes all of the powers of the Universe including earth -- and the things that come from the earth, water, fire and air.

The Sweat Lodge Ceremony is one of the most sacred ceremonies used in the Native American culture. It is often held as the precursor for those attending other traditional sacred or social ceremonies, for it is said to empower our natural being with the four elements of fire, water, air and earth.

Our Sweat Lodge is open to all who want to participate and experience the beauty and wonder of this most powerful and cleansing ceremony. It is a place to repair your spirit, of refuge and healing, and to obtain personal answers and guidance.

Full Moon Cedar Baths for Women

These **women only** ceremonies are profoundly grounding, and spiritually and emotionally uplifting. Built on time-honored Native American traditions, you will be transported to a time of many moons ago ... when women came together to honor and replenish their spirit, their life and their very Being.

Sacred Pipe Prayer Circle

We as caretakers of the earth do have the power to affect these changes in a significant and positive manner. The time is now to make a choice between believing in the fear-based media generated patterns, or to reclaim our power to create a peaceful future.

In support of what is now coming and what is yet to come, a sacred pipe prayer circle is being formed to gather together and offer our prayers and intentions to support this rebirthing process. In this way we can move through these changes wholly and authentically. The Prayer Pipe is a ceremonial tool through which prayers and gratitude are sent to the Great Mystery and to signify peace among all nations. The sacred smoke is the breath made visible carrying the prayers upward to the Source of all breath.
